Community Based Services (CBS)

Service Area:

Sutter and Yuba Counties

Program Philosophy

Provide community based Specialty Mental Health Services that are integrated, collaborative, and strength based in collaboration with Sutter Yuba Behavioral Health. In addition, the program seeks to engage children and families in a supportive and therapeutic manner to promote healing, healthy decision making, and positive family dynamics.

Program Goal

To enhance the psychological, social, emotional and behavioral functioning of program participants through comprehensive, strength-based, therapeutic services, with a strong emphasis on client and family involvement.

Program Description	
Service Type:	Individual, group, and family therapy. In addition to these services behavioral support, rehabilitation services, collaborative case management, medication management, Parent Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT) are also available.
Service Location:	Services are provided at various sites including Youth for Change offices, community settings, school sites, and/or client's home.

Service Abstract

The Youth for Change Community Based Services (CBS) Program is a collaboration between Youth for Change and Sutter Yuba Behavioral Health. CBS is primarily focused on early intervention, with therapists providing services throughout both counties. The program provides therapeutic services to eligible clients (full scope Medi-Cal) referred by Sutter Yuba Behavioral Health. Services include screening, diagnosis, individual, group, and family therapy. All staff complete TCI training as well as training to support the needs of program participants.

Entry and Exit Criteria

Program entrance is based on functional impairment and the determination of access criteria for specialty mental health services. Exiting the program is based on the reduction of the level of functional impairment and/or the determination that the client could benefit from a lower level of care.

Referral, Transition, and Discharge

All referrals, transition and discharge decisions are the responsibility of the services provider and applicable treatment team(s). Referrals to other community resources will be made and documented throughout treatment, considering clients' and families' abilities and preferences. Transition planning will occur throughout the course of treatment, be discussed with clients and applicable treatment team(s) and be documented. Transition plan will include review of clients' wellbeing, therapeutic gains achieved, and client and family strengths. Discharge paperwork and client history reports will be completed and reviewed at the end of treatment with clients and caretakers as available and appropriate.
